LONG LAWFORD 10-15am Act of Remembrance at the War Memorial followed by a Service in the Memorial Hall

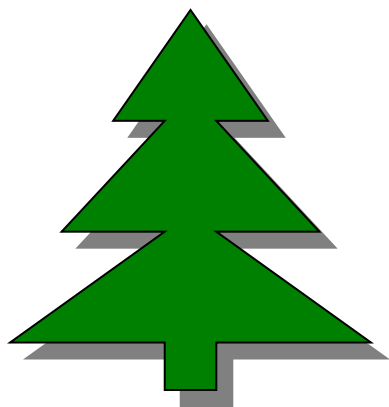
